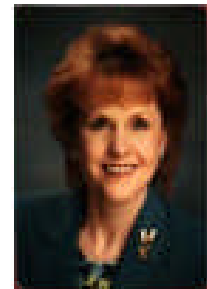

This is a wonderful time of relaxation and refreshing. If you've never been to campmeeting before, talk to someone who has and make arrangements to come up.

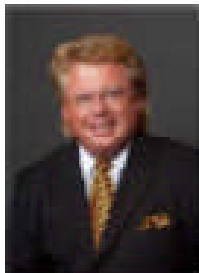
Guest Speaker: Tonya Shupe

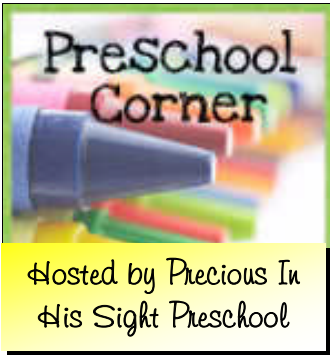
